'Eight Immortal Flavors'

CHINA-MESHI — Chinese food introduction to Chinese cooking, particularly the Cantonese cooking, by the Japanese folk tale learned by all seen is the newest of the cookbooks on "Eight Immortal Flavors," by Johnny Kan, with the great majority of Japanese Americans who grew up with Charles L. Leong.
