From the Frying Pan

IMMIGRATION—Despite its extremely crowded calendar, Congress at this writing gives indication of passing some measure to reform our immigration laws.

In support of this bill, the JACL's Washington representative, Mike Masako submitted last June an impressive document that ran 79 typewritten pages, plus 34 additional pages of notes, mostly single-spaced.

The document is almost entirely the work of Mike Masako, who devoted ten days of intensive work on it. If it were not for his complete familiarity with the problem, an effort of this magnitude would have taken many weeks.

THE FIRST IMMIGRANTS—U.S. census figures, quoted by Masako in his presentation, show that in the 40 years between 1861 and 1900, 28,597 immigrants arrived in the United States.

The first immigrant was considered to be Manjuro Nanzaka, also known as John Mung. His story was told in considerable detail in a book, "Manjuro, the Man Who Discovered America," by Hisakazu Kaneko.

Now appears Manjuro was preceded on the North American mainland by three other Japanese. They are mentioned in the book "Yankone and Samurai" by Foster Rheba.

The three were captured by Indians, held prisoners a year before a captain of a Hudson's Bay Co. ship freed them and took them to London.

The Japanese, however, fired on the American and, with the fearful Japanese castaways, who had caught no more than distant glimpses of their native land, still aboard the Morrison, returned to Macao.

Next week we'll tell you more about Manjuro and other early immigrants, including a Canadian who went to Japan first.

U.S. attitudes on Japan continue to alarm Reichsauer

CAMBRIDGE, Mass.—Ambassador to Japan Edwin G. Reischauer, currently in the United States, continued to voice alarm at the attitude of many people in the United States towards Japan.

In an interview here, he said, "We should have a closer relationship with Japan because of Vietnam. It would be much more disastrous than anything that might happen in Vietnam except a big war with itself."

Two decades after the unconditional surrender in World War II, the Ambassador notes, Japan "is still the great power of Asia."

Reichsauer said that the United States is clearly trying to play a leading, perhaps decisive role in handling the underdeveloped nations of Asia.

"What that part of the world needs more than anything else is technical know-how," says Reichsauer. "This is what Japan has to offer."

Potential Role as Ally This is Japan's potential role as a continued American ally. In the meanwhile, however, some danger signs are clearly discernible in this alliance.

In 1970, the date the 30-year association with Japan would be quietly accepted on both sides that there would be no real problem then," says the ambassador.

Perhaps even more urgent is the status of Okinawa, now under U.S. control, which is vital to the United States in defending Japan and in maintaining stability in the Far East.

On the other hand, he says, this growing national consciousness may lead Japan into a key role in advancing the peace and security of the world.

But, he adds, "large elements of the Japanese public are now growing harder for non-alignment."
