# Ye Editor's Desk

DISTRICT COUNCIL JURISDICTIONS

As a national organization primarily composed of persons of Japanese ancestry, JACL's by-laws on district councils deserve updating.

Sues are close to a half million Japanese Americans living in the 50 states, according to the 1860 U.S. census. Because of this, if appears reasonable to have our-by-laws amended to either expand district council area jurisdictions to cover all 50 states or designate several more district areas in anticipation.

JACL might as well be prepared. There is no sense in barring the formation of JACL bapters in those areas presently outside of district council area jurisdiction. A chapter to be fully chartered needs to become a member of a district council. There is a minimum of three chapters needed to organize la district council. Until a new district area includes at least there chapters, the area can be serviced by the nearest active district council.

Central California District Council might be induced to include line with its area jurisdiction though CCDC may encounter difficulty servining lays with Tioga Pass as the only highway route between the areas.

While Northern California Includes the adjoining counties of Nevada, the Pacific Southwest District Council might welcome memberships from the Law Vegas area by expanding its area jurisdictions to include their own adjoining counties of Nevada.

To pick up the other nine Nevada counties, the Intermountain District Council might add the phrase-and Nevada, except those counties adjacent to California."

To clarify the Intermountain District jurisdiction in eastern Oregon, the Paclific Northwest district boundaries may read: "Washington and so much of the states of Idaho and Oregon in the Paclific Time Zone." And Intermountain, likewise, would specify. "Ulah and so much of the states of Idaho and Oregon in the Mountain Time Zone." And if IDC feels if mecessary, the "adjoining counties of Wyoming 4a Idaho and Utah" may be incorporated in its area surisdictions.

The 10-state area of Montana, Wyoming (except for the adjoining counties to Jdaho and Utah'), Colorado, New Mexico, Texas, North and South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas and Oklahoma, could be spelled out for the Mountain-Plains District Council. From a geographic standpoint, MPDC would be the largest and unwieledy to service. Further study to formulate new districts within this area is recommended. The 10-state area of Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, Wisconsin, Illinois, Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky and West Virginia could be the basis for Midwest District Council. If the Eastern District Council didn't min being a 13-state area, it should take West Virginia could be the basis for Midwest Virginia from the Midwest jurisdiction.

The 12 states comprising the Eastern District see Maine, Vermont, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New York, Pennyivania, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland and Virginia and the District of Columbia.

Two other states not covered by the present by-laws are Alaska and Hawaii. And Hawaii because of its huge Japanese American population could easily organize several district councils within the islands.

The JACL by-laws further provides that "JACL Committees" may be organized upon approval of the National Board in areas where the minimum member requirement (of 25 channot be met. Annual dues for membership in such JACL Committees are \$5.00 single, \$9 couple, and including a year's sub-acription to the Pacific Citizen.

If the need can be stipulated for having JACL Committees in states where JACL chapters are not organized, in addition to our halling the fact that there are JACL members in all 50 states) our organization will have respect of all Americkins, I'm sure.

Perhaps the only need that ought to govern is the one expressed in the JACL preamble: "We, American citizens, is order to foster American tenocracy, promote active participation in civic and national life, and secure justice and equal opportunities for persons of Japanese ascentry, do establish this Constitution for the Japanese American Citizens League of the United States of America."
